- Always use ladder facing the vessel
- Always keep away from pinch points when folding or extending ladder
- Always step in center of tread, not to either side
- Never dive or jump from ladder
- Never use ladder with more than one person at a time
- Routinely check mounting points for loose hardware or damage

**Usage Guidelines:**

1. Locate a convenient boarding location on top of the swim platform. Provide as much clearance from the propeller as possible. Avoid weak or un-reinforced areas to prevent damage. Position the ladder so that the lowest tread of the ladder will be at least 12" (30.48 cm) below the surface when fully extended.
2. Check clearances with the ladder in both up and down configurations before mounting hardware. Check for items behind mounting bracket locations to prevent damage when drilling holes.
3. Position mounting brackets and drill holes for hardware. Fasten brackets securely to platform using stainless thru-bolts and backing plates with locking nuts. Use polyurethane sealer when installing hardware to prevent water damage of platform.
4. When ladder is not in use collapse telescoping sections and fold onto top of swim platform or step. Secure ladder with provided Velcro® strap.
